Domestic Violence Support Group

We offer English and Spanish speaking support groups. Our therapists educate groups on the effects of abuse, how to safety plan, dysfunctional thinking patterns, effects of abuse on children, teaching healthy boundaries, and much more.

Window For Art

LVF offers healing through art for children ages 4 and up. This program provides an arena for safety, builds self-esteem, and allows children and adults to have a constructive outlet for negative feelings.

Dialectical Behavior Therapy

This evidence-based therapy model is skills based and combines eastern concepts of mindfullness with cognitive behavioral therapy.





My Strength My Voice

This year we celebrated the success of our first My Strength My Voice, boy's empowerment retreat. We partnered with Escobar Training Grounds, Evolution Fitness, Blue Angel Café, South Lake Tahoe Police Department, and local faith Leader Rabbi Evon Yakar to mentor middle-school aged boys in order to support leadership skills, and allow students to build a positive network amongst peers.

Girls Empowerment Retreat

This is one of our most successful ongoing prevention programs. The Girls

Empowerment Retreat is for middle-school aged girls. We partnered with SUP Tahoe - Stand Up Paddle, Verde

Mexican Rotisserie and Michelle McLean to support leadership, and a network amongst peers. Historically, the retreat has included activities such as: self-defense training, self-love and sisterhood workshops, health and nutrition education, and various art projects.





Advocates for Safe & Healthy Relationships Alliance

ASHRA is our youth leadership program held at South Tahoe High School. These amazing teens are not only change makers but they volunteer, collaborate with other youth leadership groups, hold awareness events on campus, and model support and advocacy for their peers. Meetings and trainings are held weekly with our wonderful Prevention staff.

To pay our respects to Jennifer Kline and remember this incredible person, we created a Zen Garden with the intention to bring beauty and tranquility to our clients and the community at-large. We were very lucky to have an amazing group of volunteers; spanning from our youth leaders, to our wonderful community members, even helping hands from a family vacationing in Tahoe. These 18 volunteers gathered, worked together, and established a colorful landscape. We are so appreciative to the wonderful volunteers who dug in the earth and nurtured the space. This beautification project was much more than a renovation to spruce up our property; this was a statement of celebrating life and those who saved many over the years.
