In 2022, we celebrated our 45th anniversary serving the South Lake Tahoe and Alpine County communities, making an impact through our vital services and as an advocate for positive community change. In 1977, a handful of volunteers opened the South Lake Tahoe Women's Center to provide a rape crisis hotline. The volunteers operated out of a two-room cabin and began the agency's most important service.
